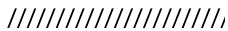

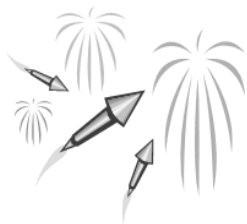

Victoria Day 2017 – Important Notice

In order to reduce congestion and help ensure access for emergency vehicles, Wilmot Township has approved one-way traffic flow in this neighbourhood on Victoria Day, Monday May 22, 2017.

Signage and barriers will be in place directing traffic **southbound only on Queen St. S.** from Bridge to Poth, **westbound only on Poth Dr.** from Queen to Dundee, and **northbound only on Dundee Ave** from Poth to Bridge.
